More than 5,200 children learned about the history of money through Alpha Bank's educational programs

The travelling museum kit of the Numismatic Collection and many other educational programs of the Bank travelled extensively throughout Greece, attracting the interest of 120 schools from all over the country

More than **5,200 school students throughout Greece** were introduced to the **history and the world of money and transactions** by the Bank's educational programs, which clocked over **200 hours of learning in 120 schools**, with the participation of 229 teachers.

One of the programs that stood out was the **"A journey through the world of money"** of the Numismatic Collection, which, in the form of a travelling museum kit, visited 72 schools in the country this year. **Over 4,000 school students and 110 teachers** learned about the evolution of currency from antiquity to the present day and became familiar with **basic economic concepts** such as budgeting, savings and responsible consumption, through group activities and educational games.

In Corfu, the Banknote Museum of the Ionian Bank welcomed 864 students from 45 schools, in the context of the program **"Paper Money – The Greek Banknote"**. The program focused on the history and the art of Greek banknotes, offering experiential learning through games and activities. Moreover, 252 school students participated in the educational program **"Women in Art"**, exploring the role of Greek female artists in art and culture.

Under its **"Culture for All" initiative** and in partnership with the non-profit organization **"seveneleven"**, the Bank offered online educational activities, which combined technology with pedagogical methods. A total of 74 students participated in the relevant educational programs.
