## The CEO of Hellenic Development Bank attended Alpha Bank's Small Business Workshops in Heraklion, Crete

The CEO of HDB was present at the close of the cycle of Workshops on Small Business financing for 2025

Over 60 business owners from Heraklion, Crete had the opportunity to participate in the two last workshops for 2025.
