Iason Kepaptsoglou to take over as new Head of Alpha Bank's Investor and Analyst Relations Division

Alpha Bank announces that Mr. Iason Kepaptsoglou will assume the duties of Head of the Group's Investor and Analyst Relations Division.

Having worked for many years in the Analysis and Research Departments of leading London-based global banks, Mr. Kepaptsoglou will be taking over from Mr. Dimitris Kostopoulos, who as of 1.1.2022 assumes the duties of Alpha Finance CEO.

I. Kepaptsoglou's brief CV

Iason Kepaptsoglou was born in Thessaloniki in 1985. He has worked in the City of London since 2007 as a banks' equity research analyst, starting from the research department of Bear Stearns (currently JPMorgan) and thereafter at Credit Suisse and HSBC.

He took over coverage of domestic Spanish and Italian banks for HSBC in 2011, followed by Nordic banks and the international banks of Southern Europe. His coverage of Greek banks started in 2015.

Beyond sector and company reports, he has published notes on pan-European bank strategy and regulatory issues.

He holds an MSc in Banking and International Finance from Bayes (previously Cass) Business School as well as a BSc in Economics from the University of Warwick.
