Students from the schools of the island will have the opportunity to get acquainted with the coins of the New Greek State, through [the new digital application](#) created by the Alpha Bank Numismatic Collection.

The action begins with a **game of searching for selected iconic banknotes** in the permanent exhibition on the 1st floor and continues to the 2nd floor, where Coin-o-rama is installed. Students will discover coins from different historical periods, compare iconography and inscriptions, meet historical figures and complete an educational booklet.
