## Important Notice Mandatory transfer of data to the IAPR myDATA digital platform

As is the case with all credit institutions operating in Greece and in accordance with the tax legislation in force, and specifically Joint Decision No. A.1138/2020 issued by the Deputy Minister of Finance and the Governor of the IAPR, ALPHA BANK is obliged to transfer to the Independent Authority for Public Revenue (IAPR) detailed supporting documents of its revenues, as well as the interest on deposits (its expenses) it pays out to business customers (legal entities, sole proprietorships and other freelance professionals).

In this context, customers belonging to the above categories will receive from the Bank supporting documents of transactions as issued and transferred to the IAPR and which pertain to their professional activities, so they may meet their tax liabilities. The documents will be sent in one of the following ways:

## - Through web banking for customers who have signed up to e-Banking

The process is very simple. You only need to log into your web banking and choose "My documents" > "Invoices" to get online access to the invoices the Bank issues for your business and transfers to the IAPR myDATA digital platform.

## - Through email, only for customers who have not signed up to e-Banking (at their registered email address)

If you do not have e-Banking credentials and have not registered your email address with the Bank or have changed your email address, visit an ALPHA BANK branch to update your personal details and get e-Banking credentials.
